


# **PREP**


Every great show has a stage. Help create and decorate yours.

# SING WATCH NOW


#### MAKE A BACKDROP FOR YOUR PERFORMERS

MATERIALS: Crepe paper streamers, construction paper, masking tape, scissors


INSTRUCTIONS: Find the wall you are going to perform in front of. Stretch a piece of masking tape high on the wall, sticky side out, and use two smaller pieces of tape to adhere it to the wall. With your scissors, cut the paper streamers and stick them to the line of tape so the other end dangles to the ground. Repeat this until your stage area is covered. Cut out star and moon shapes from your construction paper to stick to the streamers. Be creative!



Attach tape to the wall.



Hang colorful streamers.




Decorate with paper shapes.


#### MAKE A SPOTLIGHT TO SHOWCASE YOUR STARS

MATERIALS: Colored tissue paper, flashlight, rubber band



# **SNACK BAR**

#### **RECIPES/SNACKS**

#### **MEENA'S STRAWBERRY SHAKE**

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 3/4 cup ripe strawberries, cut off stems
- 1/2 cup milk, (coconut or almond work too)
- 1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 1/2 cup ice

INSTRUCTIONS: Add all of the ingredients to your blender and blend until smooth.

Make sure to have adult supervision when operating the blender.




#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 8 plain mini bagels
- 1 cup pizza sauce
- 8 oz. shredded mozzarella
- 24 pepperonis, cut in half
- Parsley and grated parmesan (optional)

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Heat oven to 425 degrees.
- Lay bagels cut side up on a parchment-lined baking sheet.
- Add a spoonful of pizza sauce to each bagel, spreading it in an even layer.
- Divide the cheese evenly between the bagels and add pepperonis.
- Bake for about 12 minutes or until the cheese is melted.
- Garnish with fresh parsley and grated parmesan if desired and enjoy!







# **SNACK BAR**

#### **RECIPES/SNACKS**

#### **PORSHA'S POPCORN**

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

• 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil or coconut oil

• 1/2 cup popcorn kernels, divided

• Salt, to taste

Multicolor sprinkles

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

 Pour the oil and kernels into sauce pan and cover. Set on the stove over medium heat. Wait. You'll hear the popcorn begin to sizzle. Keep waiting. (Have a pair of oven mitts at the ready!) Eventually, you'll hear the first pop.

 Once the first kernel pops, start shaking the pot, holding onto the lid so it doesn't fly off. Keep on shaking as the popping rate increases—this is key to avoid burning the kernels. After 2 or 3 minutes, the popping will slow down and eventually putter to an infrequent pop. Remove the pot from the heat.

 Pour your melted butter over the popcorn and shake. I like to do this right in the pan and add the salt last so it adheres more evenly.

 Add multicolor sprinkles to bring fashionable magic to your movie night!


# SING WATCH NOW

#### MAKE AWARDS FOR YOUR PERFORMERS


Cap off your talent show with fun, amazing awards to celebrate all the great talents you've shared!
